In Japanese, with only a couple of exceptions, we can convert adjectives into adverbs by doing one of two things, depending on the type of adjective we're dealing with. Here's how: As you can see, i-adjectives can be turned into adverbs by changing the "i" 「い」 to "ku" 「く」, while for na-adjectives, we just replace the "na" 「な」 with "ni" 「に」.

For example, every adjective in the continuative form can be used as an adverb; thus, 弱い yowai 'weak' (adj) 弱く yowaku 'weakly' (adv).

Moreover, many do not translate into adverbs in English. The role these parts of speech play in adding flavor to the Japanese language is invaluable.
